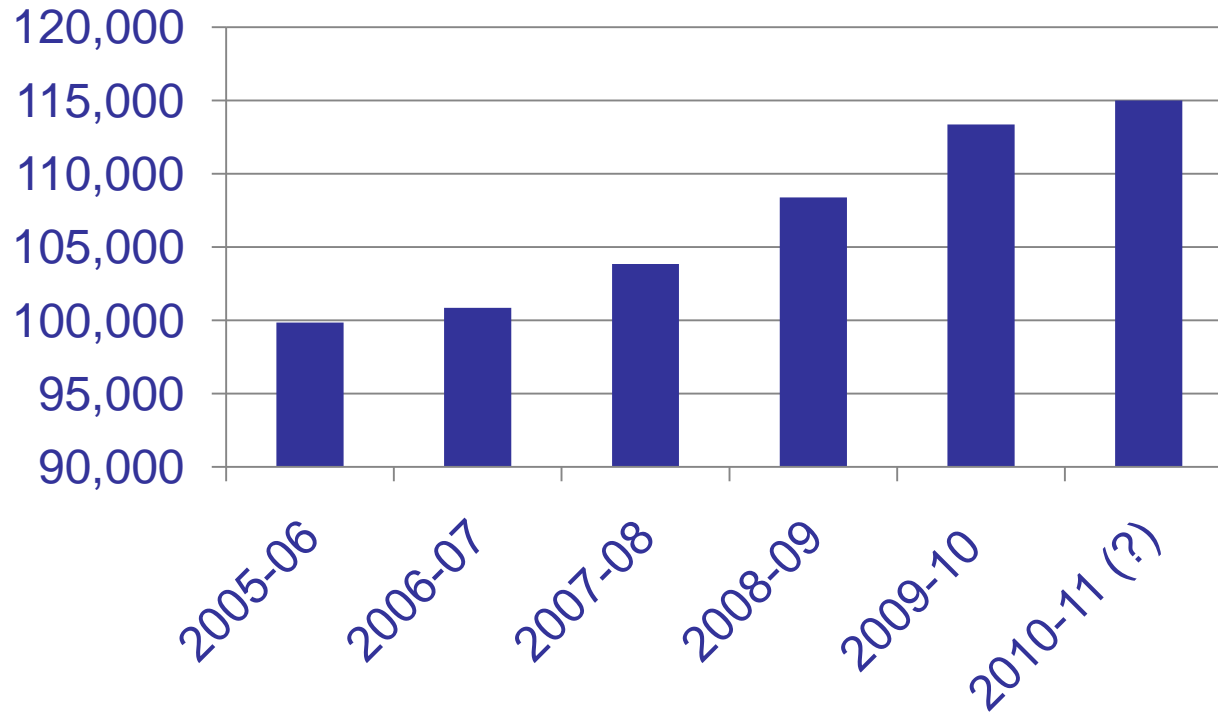

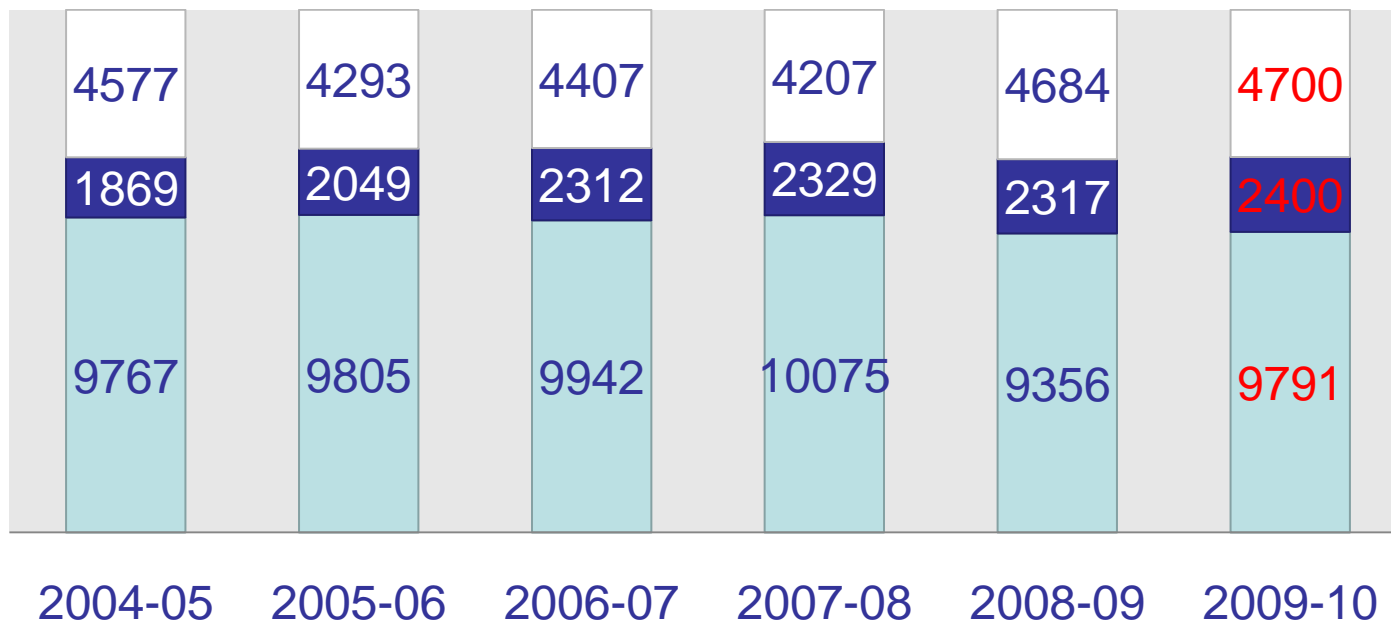
Transfer Intent Students (HC)
