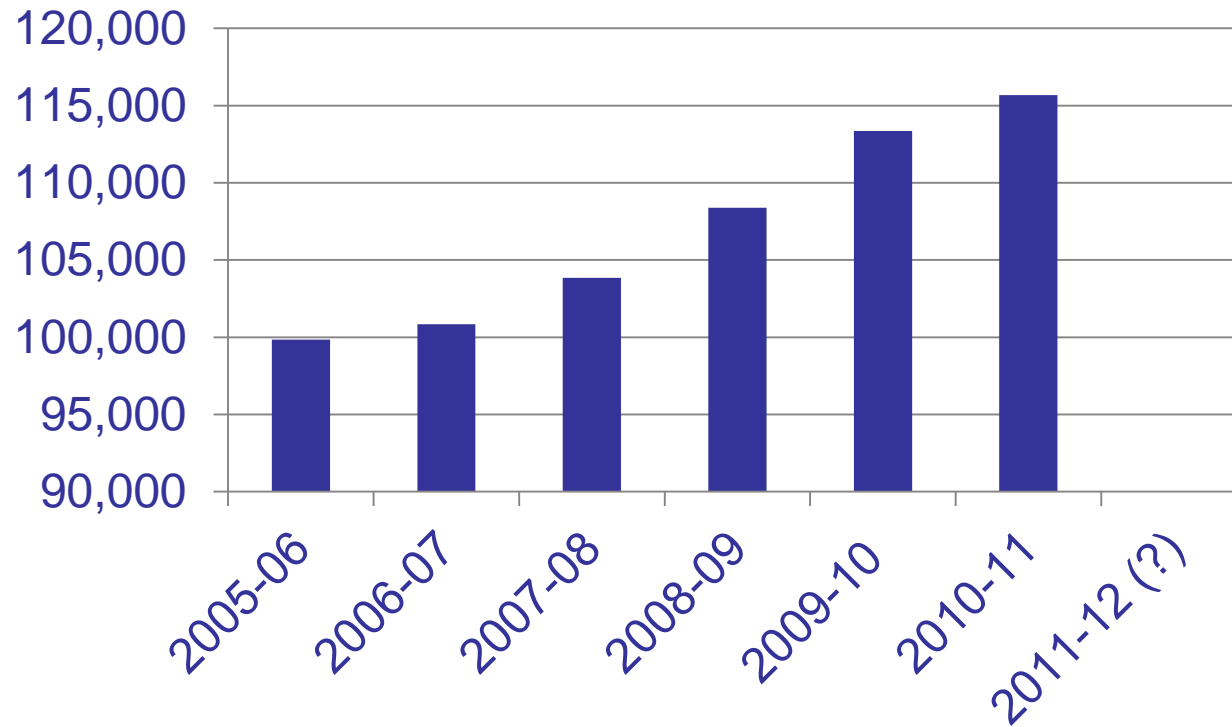

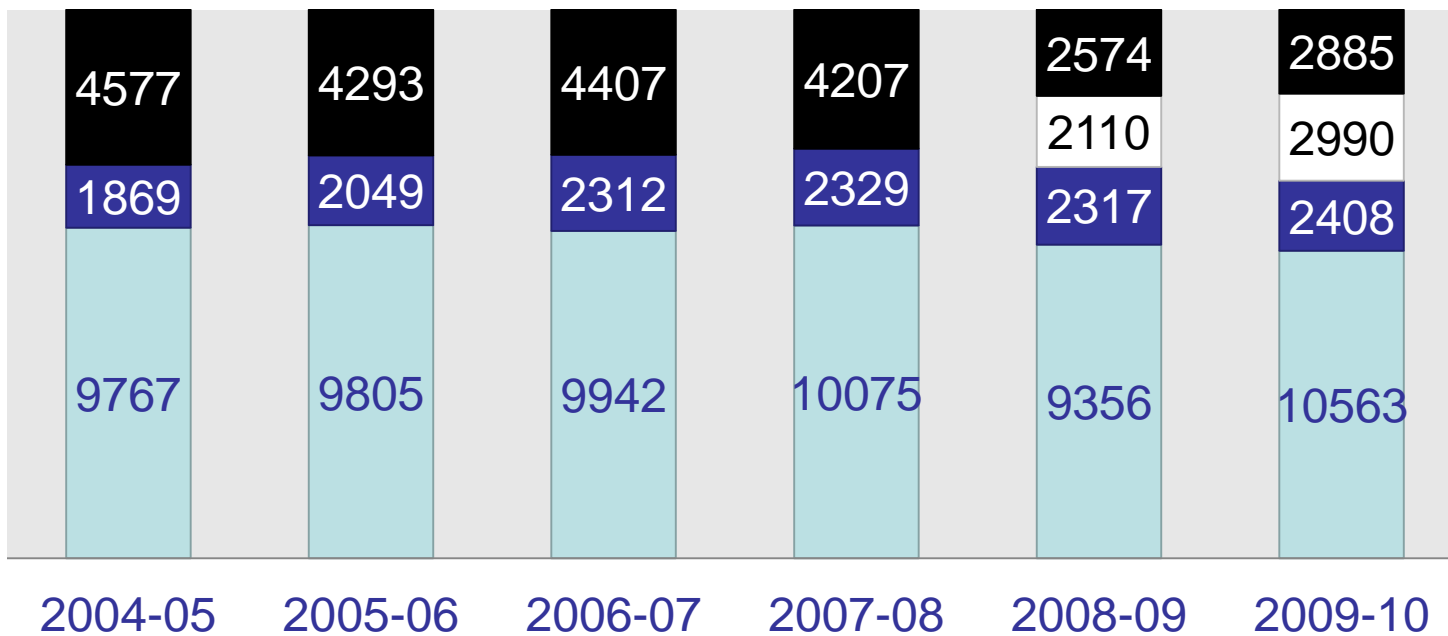
Transfer Intent Students (HC)

2011 Legislature

- **Bill Number: 5463**
 - *Common Student Identifier* between community and technical colleges
- **Bill Number: 1808**
 - Master list of postsecondary course that can be fulfilled by taking recognized college level proficiency exams such as AP, IB, and CLEP and meeting qualifying score
 - Provide master list of courses to OSPI for distribution to school districts
- **Bill Number: 1795**
 - List of common courses transferable to all four-year public colleges
 - Increase awards of academic credit for *Prior Learning*
 - One-year Academic Credential
